Scholarship Award

The Michigan AEYC Student Leadership Scholarship provides opportunities for education and leadership to an undergraduate student who is pursuing a Bachelor's Degree in child development, or elementary certification with the early childhood endorsement, Birth-Kindergarten (B-K, or Lower Elementary Education Endorsement (PK-3). The purpose of providing this scholarship is to develop a base for future leadership both in the profession and in the association.

This scholarship is given to a student each year who, through his/her academic record and professional involvement, indicate strong leadership skills in the field of early childhood education or child development.

Early Childhood Education Scholarship

- Child Development
- Early Childhood Education
